Congrats to Jazz I (Mr. Cox) on a GOLD rating with Distinction and Jazz II – (Mr. Bess) on the GOLD rating! Jazz I plays in the Group division – the most difficult music and Jazz II was in Group 3. Several soloists earned a special award for outstanding Solos – Grayson Devening / Ari Porter / Isaiah Mason / Evan Miller / Emmajen Sosbe / and Jess Dunn (jazz I) and Drew Hainey and Drake Bradshaw (jazz II). We want to also recognize the DMS Jazz band and Ms. Davis for earning a GOLD rating. We have a proud tradition of Jazz Excellence in our program.
