April 7th, 8th, & 9th **WGI WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS**- Dayton Ohio

(will depart for Dayton Ohio on Wednesday the 6th)

We will be rehearsing and staying as a group in Dayton. Our hotel details will be disclosed as we near that date. More information to come!!!

The cost of this for a 3 night stay will ROUGHLY be \$100.00.

IF YOU MISS REHEARSAL, FOR ANY REASON, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO MAKE UP ALL MATERIAL BEFORE THE NEXT REHEARSAL. This is the individual's responsibility!

The object (much like school) is to achieve perfect attendance so that all material is current and there is never an opportunity to fall behind in any aspect of the show. Injuries

Being in winter guard is or any physical activity can put strain on the body and injuries can occur. If your daughter is injured beyond the normal bumps and bruises, please make sure that you communicate this to Meghan and Mr. Cox ASAP. **Please have your daughter bring in any doctors notes that will help explain treatment/injury.**

Reminder: If your daughter has an injured finger, she can still march her drill and practice her dancing. If she has an injured toe, she can still spin with her hands. We need everyone to attend all rehearsals even if they cannot participate 100%. At the very least they can sit on the sideline and listen to rehearsal---valuable information.

If she is contagious---PLEASE keep her home! ☺

Guard Class

We ask that all members of the winter guard join in the 8th period class for the 2016 spring semester. This class will act as an extra hour of precious rehearsal time. Here we will work on movement and technique skills that are imperative to our overall success in A class. Class will run into after school rehearsal on Tuesdays and Thursdays (with a quick snack break) so planning is a must.

We are currently working on transportation for those 8th graders interested in attending ALL classes during the week. Ideally they would be confirmed to ride the HIGH SCHOOL busses home. We will keep you posted on progress. Until then, they are only required to join us on Tuesdays and Thursdays when rehearsal immediately follows.

What is the cost for the Scholastic A guard?

The total cost for this year's winter guard is \$400.00. The cost will be broken into 4 even instalments. All payment deadlines fall on the second Friday of each month from December through March. If making a payment becomes an issue, please contact Mr. Cox and myself IMMEDIATELY. These issues can usually be resolved so long as there is a fluid communication process. Lack of communication will only create more issues.

What do my fees cover?

To put it into a bit of perspective here is a list of general expenses for the 2016 Winter Guard production.

Flags \$1800

Uniforms \$3300

Tarp/props \$3000

Paint/supplies \$700

Equipment maintenance \$1000

Show Makeup \$200

For a total of an estimated \$10,000

If we were to divide the number of students, 16 by the amount of money \$10,000 we would have fees close to \$625.00. Notice the cost of staff, music cuts, choreography as well as competition fees are not listed above. All of the money collected in fees goes towards all that you see listed above. Decatur is very fortunate in the fact that we have

one of the lowest membership fees in the entire state. Most groups are paying anywhere from \$800.00-\$1000.00. Let's try to keep it this way by making sure to consistently contribute our dues in a timely manner.

Fundraising

We are currently in search of a few fun and enticing fundraisers to help cover the total cost of winter guard. It will be mandatory that each member meet a quota for each fundraiser or must pay the difference. Obviously this is an amazing opportunity to help take the financial load off of you and allows our child to take a bit of the dues into their own hands. A few ideas that have been passed around (but not yet finalized) are:

- Chocolate bars (EVERYONE LOVES THIS)
- Pizza fundraiser - we participated in this fundraiser and made approximately \$700.00 for the A guard alone.
- Pasta Sale
- Braided Buns (another favorite)
- Coffee (based out of Bloomington)
- Fundraiser dinner: Fazolies, Applebee's, City BarBQ

Just to name a few. If you know of any AWESOME fundraisers that you have done or have contributed to in the past, please feel free to forward me the information! The more fundraising we do the less your bank account has to do!

Additional costs NOT covered in Fees:

- Proper dance attire for rehearsals- i.e. sports bras (requirement), spandex tops and bottoms (preferably black) generally form fitting clothes.
- NUDE seamless under garments for performances. This is a must as the uniforms can be a bit transparent when wearing colors other than nude.
- Body tights- nude. Not mandatory as we have unitards to lend out, just strongly suggested.
- Extra gloves should something happen to the first pair of gloves.
- Hair products for styling the show look. Hair spray, bobby pins, hair ties, combs, etc.
- Rifles from designsbykyng.com should your daughter make a rifle line.
- A pitch in item for the guard box i.e. band aids, hand sanitizer, feminine products etc

- A PAIR OF BLACK FLIP FLOPS This is an absolute must as we near our competition season. We will be wearing these during competition. It is important that we look the same while transiting throughout the hallways at shows. We want to look like a team/unit. Create OUR OWN image and it starts with the little details.
- Hotel Room for WGI

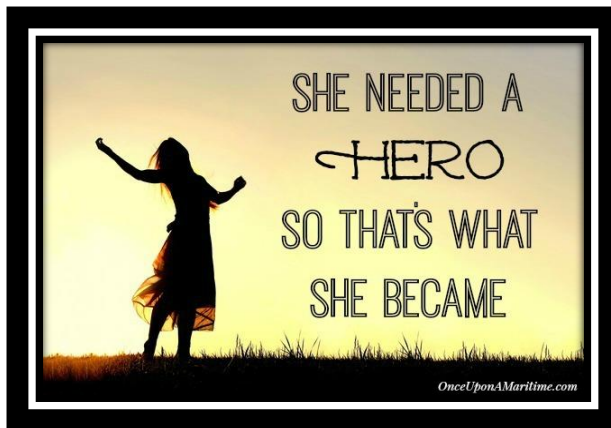
Speaking of little details....
